

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

BEFORE YOU COME

Please do not come to church if you are feeling unwell or if you are self-isolating whilst someone in your household is unwell.

Please bring a pen if you would like to complete a Blue Gift Aid envelope

If you are bringing collection please use your usual envelope. If you do not have a Planned Giving envelope please bring your offering in your own sealed envelope. Alternatively you can make a transfer direct to the church account.

There will be baskets to collect any envelopes brought to church

Face coverings or masks are not necessary – if you feel safer wearing one please do so

There will not be any children's activities available and the children's corner will be shut.

ARRIVING

Please use sanitiser as you enter and as you leave church

You will be asked for your name as you enter so that we can keep "track and trace" records for each service for 21 days. To speed up this process you could write your name and phone number on a piece of paper and drop it in the designated box as you enter.

Families and other bubbles can sit together. There will be four designated family pews set aside.

DURING THE SERVICE

We are not allowed to share the peace physically. Acknowledge those nearest to you but do not move.

When you leave your pew please exit by the nearest end. Do not walk through the length of the pew.

Church WC available. Only one person in vestry corridor at a time. Please wait in the church by the font. Please use sanitiser before and after.

Please keep to your seat other than for communion – we have to clean everywhere that is touched!

COMMUNION

Administration of Communion: approach down central aisle in single file. Discreet marks on floor to show social distancing. Communion will be administered standing. Please exit to left and right – do not go back up the central aisle.

Please use hand sanitiser before receiving communion if you can. If you have your own it would be helpful but the wardens will have sanitiser available at the back of the nave if you would like to use the church sanitiser

Communion will be in one kind only. The wine will not be offered to anyone.

AT THE END

Candles may only be lit after the service. Please make sure any hand sanitiser is well absorbed before lighting a candle.

Please take away your service sheet at the end of the service so that no one else has to handle it.

Please leave by the West Door if you are in the north side of the church. If you are on the south side please use the south door. Please leave swiftly as we will have to clean for the next service.

Services in church will contain some elements of the services of recent months – some recorded readings and music.

Online services will continue as before.
